







The Arcadia Performing Arts Center you enjoy today is the realization of a long-standing dream for the residents of Arcadia to have a major center for arts and culture in our community. This dream was realized through the community's overwhelming support of Measure I in 2006.

The Arcadia Performing Arts Center is a gem among the many exciting improvements on the high school campus. This \$20 million, 40,000 square foot, state-of-the-art facility includes a main performance hall with seating for 1,200, a stage that holds 200 musicians, tunable acoustics, and professional lighting and sound.

In addition, the center boasts an orchestra room with practice rooms and music library, a dance studio with sprung wood floors, a professional stagecraft workshop, and a Black Box theater with its own professional control room and flexible seating that can host 125 guests.

It's been three years since we opened this wonderful facility, and we are pleased to say that we are thriving and well on the way to achieving our mission to making the Arcadia Performing Arts Center a cultural destination for Southern California and a state-of- the-art teaching venue!

# The TOWNE SINGERS


#### "It's About Time!"

The thriving Arcadia High School Dance Department's top-notch Orchesis Dance Company hosts two major events during the school year: The Charity Dance Show and the Spring Dance Production.

The Charity Dance Show will be held at the Arcadia Performing Arts Center, (APAC), on December 11, 2015. The Charity Dance Show, (CDS), gives beginning dancers the opportunity to share the stage with seasoned pros! The CDS features performances by professional dance companies as well as AHS's beginning and intermediate dance students and Orchesis. In the past such varied groups as the Laker Girls, Fuse Modern, and Pasadena Dance Theater Ballet Company have taken part in the same program. The CDS recipient is researched and decided upon by Orchesis members.

The audition process is a valuable experience for Orchesis members, some of whom will go on to pursue dance as a career.

# ARCADIA HIGH SCHOOL STAGECRAFT:

A Hidden Gem of a Program!

If you've attended an Arcadia High School Theater performance, you were likely dazzled by sound, lighting, sets and costumes created by **AHS Stagecraft** class.

APAC Theater Manager and Teacher, Keith Deluca, begins his course with a lengthy unit on safety, followed by training in using tools. This is a unique opportunity for students to learn woodworking, and for most students this is their first exposure to woodworking tools.

Stagecraft students choose an area in which to specialize such as lighting, set building, sound, audio or costuming. A set's overall design is the result of input from all Stagecraft students.

The students work together as a team, collaborating creatively, respecting each other's unique contribution, and developing respect for a variety of personalities. Leadership skills are developed as returning students mentor those new to the program.

Students learn the process of set design through coming up with a plan together, submitting it for input from Mr. DeLuca and AHS Drama Instructor Steven Volpe, then making adjustments according to the feedback they receive.

Stagecraft students are deservedly proud of what they create, enthusiastic about skills they've learned and adamant about the value of teamwork. The Stagecraft Program is a hidden gem. Through it, students learn skills that will benefit any future career they choose.
